New Business – The Explorer Post is holding a Pancake Breakfast on Saturday, April 13th from 8:00-11:00 a.m. Motion passed to sell old tables & chairs, but give Mike the grill (post able to use it if needed). There will be a flag retirement ceremony in July. Estimated cost is \$273 for small bin to hold flags; however, Rick will contact a colleague to see if he can build one and associated cost.
