out a signup sheet for members to serve in the booth during designated hours.

* Service Officer Mike Corathers advised that CVP paid \$250 for two Korea/Vietnam plaques for our Veterans Post.

* Commander presented schematic and proposal for paving parking lot at our Copley Veterans Post and why S&K Asphalt was selected to do the job for \$13,400 plus \$12 per ton if additional grindings are needed; Motion was made, seconded and approved for the AL Post 473 to fund \$6,900 for the project; CVP will be asked to approve the project and for the VFW to also fund \$6,900 for the project.
